Clarence Darrow:

**The Legal Practice of an Infamous Attorney and
American Iconoclast**

Palm Beach, FL - The Flagler Museum's 31st annual Whitehall Lecture Series presents *Clarence Darrow: The Legal Practice of an Infamous Attorney and American Iconoclast* on Sunday, February 21st at 3:00 p.m. Tickets are free for Museum Members at the Sustaining level and above, \$10 for Individual, Family, and Life Members, and \$28 for non-members.

Andrew Kersten, Dean of the College of Letters, Arts and Social Sciences at the University of Idaho, and author of *Clarence Darrow: American Iconoclast* will present the lecture.

During his storied career, Clarence Darrow defended corporations and individuals alike and is remembered as a fierce orator and crafty defense attorney. However, his reputation was repeatedly called into question during the most high-profile cases of his career. Author and professor, Andrew Kersten, will discuss the legal practices of Darrow, as seen through his most widely-publicized trials.

Today, Whitehall is a National Historic Landmark and is open to the public as the Flagler Museum, featuring guided tours, changing

exhibits, and special programs. The Museum is located at One Whitehall Way, Palm Beach. The Museum is open from 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Tuesday through Saturday, and noon until 5:00 p.m., Sunday.
